

# 2022 Year-End Recital Information

## **Dress Rehearsal**

Friday, May 6 - 4:45 pm to 8:30 pm - Seven Generations Event Centre

- Dress rehearsal is an opportunity to practice the performances in costume and on stage with performance lighting before the actual show. Attendance is mandatory for all dancers. If a family emergency or illness prevents participation please notify Erin by text at 807-464-3666.
- To reduce the time commitment for the youngest dancers, dress rehearsal will run in an age-based order rather than actual show order.
  - Creative Movement & Dance Foundations Arrive by 4:45 pm & Pickup at 6:15 pm
  - Primary & Junior Arrive by 5:15 pm & Pickup at 7:30 pm
  - o Intermediate & Senior Arrive by 5:45 pm & Pickup at 8:30 pm
- Volunteers and dancers will be the only ones allowed to stay in the auditorium for rehearsal.
- Dancers will be able to sit and watch other groups perform at dress rehearsal. Masks are
  required when dancers are not rehearsing on stage. For capacity and safety reasons dancers
  will be required to stay backstage for the Saturday performances.

#### Year-End Recital

Saturday, May 7 - Shows at 1:30pm & 6:30pm - Seven Generations Event Centre

- All classes and dancers participate in <u>both</u> showtimes. Run time is approximately 75 minutes. If an emergency or illness prevents participation please notify Erin by text at 807-464-3666
  - Volunteers and Senior dancers arrive 1 hour prior to curtain.
  - o Primary/Junior/Intermediate classes arrive 45 minutes prior to curtain.
  - o Creative Movement and Dance Foundations classes arrive 20 minutes prior to curtain.
- Performers will remain backstage for the length of each show. <u>For safety reasons, the backstage area is limited to dancers and volunteers only for the duration of each show.</u>
- After the show ends one parent/guardian can return backstage to pick their dancer up. Pickup for all dancers is 3:00 pm for the afternoon show and 8:00 pm for the evening show.
- Snacks and activities are provided backstage to keep the dancers energized and entertained
  while they are waiting. You are welcome to pack your own snacks (no nuts please!) and
  dancers can bring books or other items backstage with them as well.

\*\*\*Please plan to arrive <u>no later</u> than the times listed above <u>with all hair and makeup done</u>.

Costumes can be worn in or changed into upon arrival.

Be mindful of weather conditions if wearing the costume in and out of the venue.\*\*\*

Costumes, hair, and makeup requirements for each class are noted in the DWK 2022 Costumes, Hair & Makeup note.

### **Volunteers**

Note: Any parents volunteering at both the matinee and evening shows will receive a free copy of the digital download when it is available.

### **Tickets**

Recital tickets are \$20 for adults and \$15 for youth and can be purchased online in advance at danceworkskenora.com. Tickets are general admission. Doors open 30 minutes before showtime. Everyone attending (including children over 12 months) must have a ticket. Note: The venue requires that everyone attending wear a mask.

Due to continuing venue capacity restrictions we have set up priority ticket sales for dance families this year. Each family will receive a priority code, sent to the primary account contact, that allows for the purchase of a maximum of 3 tickets (or 6 tickets for families with multiple dancers). Priority access will be active from Tuesday, April 26 at 12 noon until Monday, May 2 at 12 noon.

Open ticket sales for any remaining tickets will begin on May 2 at noon and run until Friday, May 6 at 11:59 pm on a first come, first served basis. It is highly recommended that you purchase tickets online in advance with your priority code. There is no guarantee of tickets still being available after the priority window or at the door.

# **Digital Download & Video on Demand**

The recital will be professionally filmed and will be available for streaming or download, through the online ticketing site, from Friday, May 13 through Wednesday, May 25.

#### Costumes

Costumes remain the responsibility of dancers and their families until after the recital. **Dancers will return their costume(s) to the studio at their last classes running May 9 to 13** (except for classes participating at competition later in May). No costumes will be accepted for return immediately after the recital in order to ensure proper sign-off on all costume returns.

<u>Reminder:</u> A costume replacement fee of \$80+HST will be charged to your account if the costume is not returned or is returned damaged. (Any tights included with a costume do not need to be returned.)
