



2026 Recital Information for Families

Please read through the detailed information carefully. It should provide the answers to any of your recital related questions. If you still have questions after reviewing you can reach Erin at info@danceworkskenora.com or by calling or texting 807-464-3666.

IMPORTANT: To provide enough audience capacity we have two different recitals with two showtimes each. Pay attention when reviewing schedules and buying tickets. All events take place at the Beaver Brae Theatre.

- Dancers are required to sign in/out with the volunteers at each event. Dancers age 12 and under must be signed in/out by a parent or guardian.
- The backstage dressing rooms and the theatre at rehearsal are limited to dancers and volunteers only.
 - Dancers will be able to sit in the theatre to watch other groups perform at dress rehearsal. For the shows, dancers will remain in the backstage dressing rooms for the duration of the event.
 - Some snacks and activities are provided backstage. Dancers are encouraged to bring their own snacks (no nuts please!), a water bottle, and can bring books or other items to help pass time.
- Dress rehearsal is an opportunity for dancers and the stage crew to prepare the performances in full costume and on stage with lighting and tech cues. Attendance is mandatory.

SHOW A

Creative Movement & Dance Foundations (plus Ensemble & Student Choreography)

Dress Rehearsal - Friday, May 8 - 4:30 pm to 5:45 pm - Beaver Brae Theatre

- Makeup is optional for dress rehearsal for Creative Movement & Dance Foundations classes.

Morning Shows - Saturday, May 9 - 10:00 am & 11:00 am - Beaver Brae Theatre

- There will be 20 minutes for the audience to change over between shows. Dancers will remain in the backstage dressing rooms with the volunteers during this time (all classes perform in both showtimes).

SHOW B

Primary, Junior, Intermediate, & Senior (plus Ensemble & Student Choreography)

Dress Rehearsal - Friday, May 8 - 5:30 pm to 8:30 pm - Beaver Brae Theatre

- We will run the dress rehearsal in a slightly adjusted order to allow earlier pickup for Primary dancers.

Matinee & Evening Shows - Saturday, May 9 - Shows at 1:30 pm & 6:30 pm - Beaver Brae Theatre

- All classes participate in both showtimes. Run time is approximately 2 hours. Performers will remain in the backstage areas for the length of each show. All dancers return to the stage for the curtain call at the end.

Recital Video

The recital will be professionally filmed and will be available to dance families approximately 2 weeks after the show. Reminder: Our all-inclusive pricing includes a digital download for each dancer! Access to your free digital download will be sent to the primary account contact once the video is available online.

With this video provided to all dance families we request that you follow theatre etiquette and not take any video or photos during the show. It is distracting to the dancers and to the audience members around you.

Tickets

Tickets are general admission and can be purchased online in advance at danceworkskenora.com. Doors open 20 to 30 minutes before showtime. Children under age 1 do not require a ticket but must be seated on a lap.

Priority access will be active from Monday, April 27 at noon until Saturday, May 2 at noon.

- Each family will receive a priority code, sent to the primary account contact, that allows for the purchase of up to 3 tickets (or 5 tickets for families with multiple dancers in a show).
- *Note: Accounts with a past due balance that have not already made payment arrangements with the studio will not be provided with a priority code for tickets.*

Open ticket sales for unclaimed priority tickets and any remaining tickets will begin on May 2 at noon and run until Friday, May 8 at midnight on a first come, first served basis. Tickets at the door (cash only) as available.

Costumes

Dancers will return their costume(s) and any costume accessories to the studio from May 11 to 24, 2026. For tracking purposes, costumes cannot be returned at recital. Late costume returns will result in a late return fee of \$30 per costume. Unreturned or damaged costumes will result in a replacement fee of \$110 per costume.
